As race director, planning is in full steam ahead, Graham County Board of Supervisors gave their approval for this event. I have applied for permits with ADOT, US Forest Service and the Federal Prison. So we are having the 42nd Mt. Graham Hill Climb in 2021.

I will be keeping myself updated on the Covid-19 situation.

Registration will be on Bikereg.com & I will use "wait-listed" method so that rider can save a place in the race however will not be charged until closer to race to the race date thus saving having to refund entry fee if the race can not be held due to Covid-19.

As of June 12, 2021, I am hopeful that we will be able to use "Plan A". I highly encourage all cyclist and support members to get vaccinated against the Covid-19 virus!

Plan "A" is to have the event as a mass start event with the pre-race get together in the parking area, the mass start and them the awards with a free lunch held at the Graham County multi purpose room in Safford. Registration would be both on-line and in person as in the past years. Number(s) pick up would be at the hotel and at the start line!

Plan "B" would be to conduct the Mt. Graham Hill Climb as a time trial with 30-seconds intervals between racers. If this is the case, I would eliminate the pre-race get together and awards/lunch after the event. Awards would be mail to winners. Registration would only be on-line or by mail. Number(s) would/could be mail to riders in advance!

Plan "C" would be to small groups if riders race together around 10 in a group. Each group of riders would be selected based on the category. Small categories would/could be grouped together. Registration would be on-line only with extra careful number pickup before the event. Pre-race events would be kept to a minimum; awards would be done at the parking area using social distancing rules.

In summary, the event is being planned, updates will be posted every two week on the web page and Facebook and bikereg.com. It will be either a mass start event, small category group race or an individual time trial. Registration is now open with only one fee – no late fee in 2021!

- Mt. Graham is located in the southeastern corner of Arizona. Mt. Graham draws riders each year to a spectacular event. The 20-mile road race starts @ mile post 115.1 across from the Federal prison (elevation 3,379 ft.) and winds up the "Swift Trail" (State Route 366) to the finish at mile post 135.1 near the Snow Flat camp ground (elevation 9,068). The 5,689 ft. climb travels through high desert grassland, oak woodlands, and alpine meadow to pine forest!
- Mt. Graham is the longest continuous bicycle race in Arizona in its 42nd year & the 3rd highest elevation gain one-day race in the United States.

USA Cycling Licenses

- 1. All riders must have a USA Cycling License to be a participant in Mt. Graham Hill Climb
- 2. USA Cycling annual & one-day licenses will be on sale during registration (day before & race day!)
- 3. One-day USA Cycling license is now \$10.00.
- 4. USA Cycling annual license will also be available at registration. Only annual licensed riders are eligible for State championship medals and State Jersey per USA Cycling rules.



First rider's finishing time will be around 9:30 am. Last rider finishing time will be around 11:00 AM. Those riders choosing to ride down the mountain will return to the parking area around 12:00 noon!

Riding Down-THE RACE IS UP THE MOUNTAIN NOT DOWN!!!

You may ride your bikes down Mt. Graham however extreme care needs to be taken when riding down the mountain! Helmets are required. The race is up the mountain NOT DOWN! Riders wanting a ride in a vehicle down the mountain ask at the start before the race OR AT THE FINISH AREA!

ALL JUNIOR RACERS AGE 16 AND UNDER MUST RACE THE 10-MILE DISTANCE ONLY. NO EXCEPTION NO MATTER WHAT CATEGORY/RANKING THE JUNIOR HOLDS.

ALL JUNIOR RACERS AGE 17 AND OLDER MUST BE A CATEGORY 3 OR ABOVE TO ENTER THE 20-MILE DISTANCE. ALL JUNIOR RACERS AGE 17 AND OLDER THAT ARE CATEGORY 4/5 MUST RACE THE 10-MILE DISTANCE. NO EXCEPTION!

IT IS HIGHLY SUGGESTED THAT ALL JUNIORS RACERS AGE 16 AND UNDER DO NOT RIDE FROM MILE POST 125 TO MILE POST 135. THIS IS A SAFETY CONCERN FOR ALL YOUNG RIDERS!

- 1. FREE food will be available at rest area past the finish line!
- 2. There will be a support vehicle provided by the event allowing all cyclists to take extra cloths and gear to the finish line! Racers are to place items in bags provided and label with name and race number then put the bag into the vehicle!

AWARDS

- 1. This is officially the Arizona State USA Cycling Hill Climb Championship Race. Each winner of all categories and age groups winner will receive the Arizona State Championship jersey. The race director pays for the jerseys.
- 2. USA Cycling State medals will be awarded to the first three cyclists in each category & age group for Arizona licensed cyclists. They are Gold, Silver & Bronze medals.
- **3.** Per the USA Cycling rule book, only those riders that have an ANNUAL license are eligible for the state championship title! ONE-DAY LICENSE RIDERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE STATE JERSEY OR MEDAL!
- **4.** Only Arizona State Annual licensed riders are eligible for the Arizona State Championship Jersey.
- **5.** Break a Mt. Graham record and receive an "Official Mt. Graham Record"!
- 6. TENTATIVE AWARDS! They may be held at the Graham County General Services Building. The building is located at 921 Thatcher Blvd., Safford, Arizona 85546. The entrance to the room is in the behind the main building.





MAP 20-mile event
