This year Mt. Graham Hill Climb is dedicated to my brother, Marty Feldhake, over the years Marty has been a phenomenal supporter and volunteer. Marty started helping in 1998 the first year I took over the race and continued for over 18 years when his health took a turn for the worse. Marty lost most of his eye sight around 2016. Marty last Mt Graham was in 2021 shortly after he had kidney failure & went on dialysis. Marty passed away on May 24, 2025 due to a hemorrhagic stroke.

The 46th Mt. Graham Hill Climb will be a mass start event for the 20-mile and 10-mile distances with the pre-race get together in the parking area. The mass start will travel up hill on Arizona State Route 366 from mile post 151.

Mt. Graham is located in the southeastern corner of Arizona. Mt. Graham draws riders each year to a spectacular event. The 20-mile road race starts @ mile post 115.1 at an elevation of 3,379 feet & winds up the "Swift Trail" (State Route 366) to the finish at mile post 135.1 near the Snow Flat camp ground at an elevation of 9,068. The 5,689 ft. climb travels through high desert grassland, oak woodlands, & alpine meadow to end up in a pine forest! Mt. Graham is the longest continuous bicycle race in Arizona in its 46th year & the 3rd highest elevation gain one-day race in the United States.

Fees include USA Cycling \$5.99 surcharge for insurance! Promoter pays this fee to USA Cycling!

USA Cycling Licenses

1. All riders must have a USA Cycling License to be a participant in Mt. Graham Hill Climb
2. USA Cycling annual & one-day licenses will be on sale during registration (day before & race day!)
3. One-day USA Cycling license is either \$15.00 or \$35.00.
4. USA Cycling annual license will also be available at registration. Only annual licensed riders are eligible for State championship medals and State Jersey per USA Cycling rules.

First rider's finishing time will be around 9:30 am. Last rider finishing time will be around 11:00 AM. Those riders choosing to ride down the mountain will return to the parking area around 12:00 noon!

Riding Down-THE RACE IS UP THE MOUNTAIN NOT DOWN!!!

You may ride your bikes down Mt. Graham however extreme care needs to be taken when riding down the mountain! Helmets are required. The race is up the mountain NOT DOWN! Riders wanting a ride in a vehicle down the mountain ask at the start before the race OR AT THE FINISH AREA!

Race Day Parking!!!! (New since 2024)!!!

Parking will now be in the Mt. Graham International Observatory Safford Base Camp area. The address is 1480 West State Route 366 Safford Arizona 85546. The parking area is on the right side of Sr 366 just across the road from the Main Entrance to the Federal Prison.

The port-a-johns will be placed in the North-West corner in the second lot.

The gate will be unlocked at 6:15 AM on Sunday so no reason to get there super early.

We will be sharing the lot with the Mt. Graham Observatory staff so we can not block any vehicle as they may have to go to the top of Mt. Graham. Volunteers will be directing you to where to park so please follow their directions. Not everyone can park in the first parking space next the entrance. If you are bringing a “trainer” to warm up on, we ask you to put the “trainer” behind your vehicle not on the side of the vehicle.

There will be a vehicle that will be able to take any clothes to the top. It will be near the entrance.

ALL RACERS MUST BE IN THE PARKING AREA AT 7:45 AM SO THAT WE CAN HAVE THE FOLLOWING: The national anthem and the prayer and “call up” of categories to line up in the parking lot. There will be a “neutral” start from the parking area to Mile Post 151.1 (the start).

The officials will be the lead vehicle for the race.

AWARDS

1. This is officially the Arizona State USA Cycling Hill Climb Championship Race. Each winner of all categories and age groups winner will receive the Arizona State Championship jersey. The race director pays for the jerseys.
2. USA Cycling State medals will be awarded to the first three cyclists in each category & age group for Arizona licensed cyclists. They are Gold, Silver & Bronze medals.
3. Per the USA Cycling rule book, only those riders that have an ANNUAL license are eligible for the state championship title! ONE-DAY LICENSE RIDERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE STATE JERSEY OR MEDAL!
4. Only Arizona State Annual licensed riders are eligible for the Arizona State Championship Jersey.
5. Break a Mt. Graham record and receive an "Official Mt. Graham Record"!
6. **AWARDS! They will be held at the Graham County General Services Building. The building is located at 921 Thatcher Blvd., Safford, Arizona 85546. The entrance to the room is in the behind the main building.**

JUNIOR RACERS: (ALL) :

Per the USA CYCLING RULE BOOK: JUNIOR RACE FOR NATIONAL AND STATE CHAMPIONSHIP NOW START AT AGE 11 TO AGE 18.

THE RACE DIRECTOR HIGHLY RECOMMENDS THAT AN ADULT RIDER FOLLOW, BEHIND THE JUNIOR, UP THE MOUNTAIN FOR THE SAFETY OF THE JUNIOR RIDER.

ALL JUNIOR RACERS AGE 16 AND UNDER MUST RACE THE 10-MILE DISTANCE ONLY. NO EXCEPTION NO MATTER WHAT CATEGORY/RANKING THE JUNIOR HOLDS.

ALL JUNIOR RACERS AGE 17 AND OLDER MUST BE A CATEGORY 3 OR ABOVE TO ENTER THE 20-MILE DISTANCE. ALL JUNIOR RACERS AGE 17 AND OLDER THAT ARE CATEGORY 4/5 MUST RACE THE 10-MILE DISTANCE. NO EXCEPTION!

IT IS HIGHLY SUGGESTED THAT ALL JUNIORS RACERS AGE 16 AND UNDER DO NOT RIDE FROM MILE POST 125 TO MILE POST 135. THIS IS A SAFETY CONCERN FOR ALL YOUNG RIDERS!

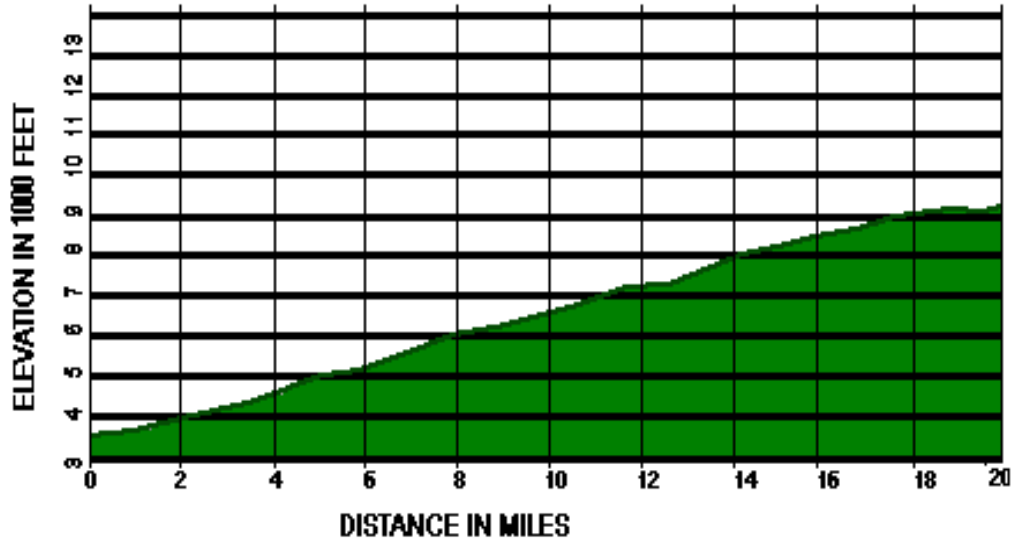

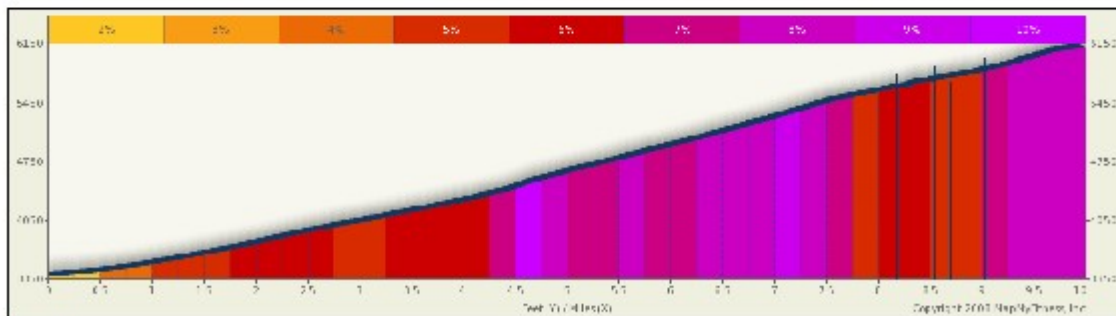
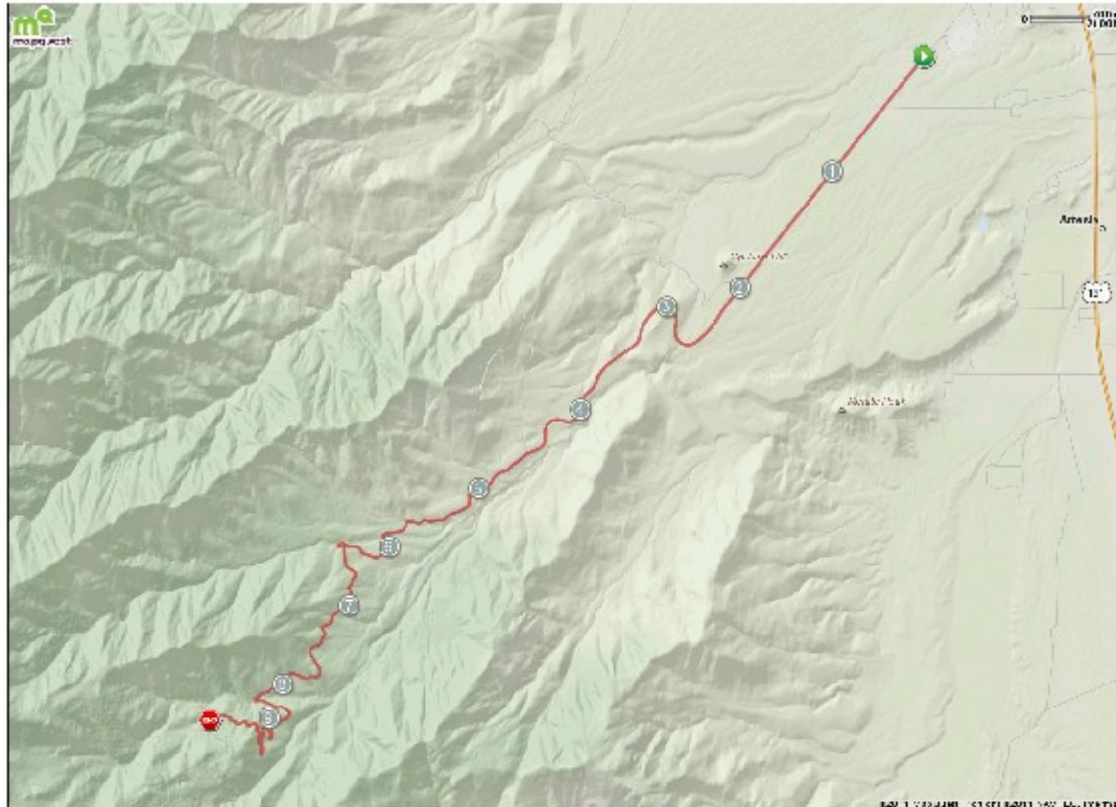
MAPS 10-mile event

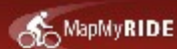

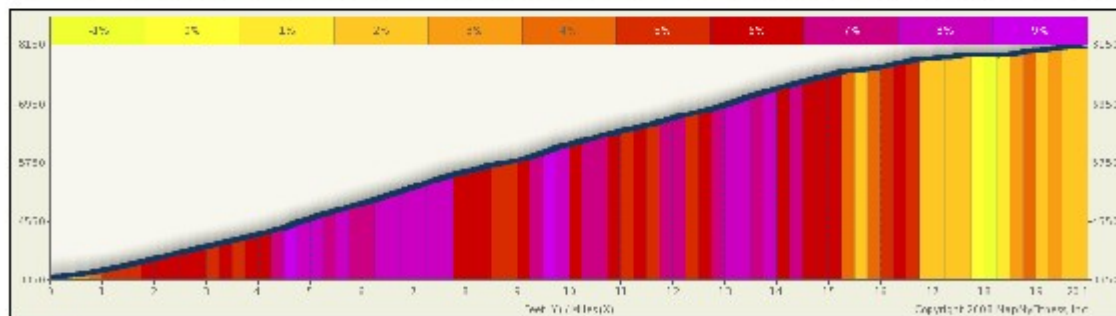
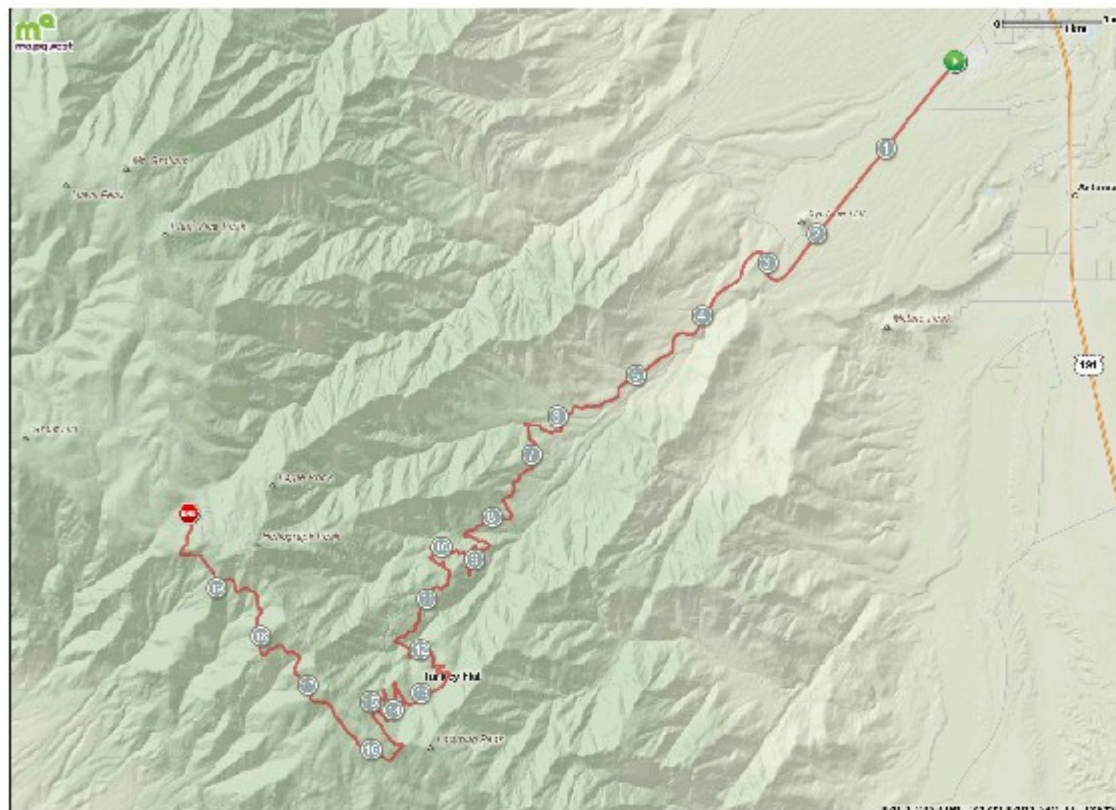
MAP 20-mile event
